1. All rules apply to the Open Boer Goat Show. Please refer to the General Rules.
2. Each livestock entry card must contain full name, address, and social security number of exhibitor, the name of breed, and the number of head entered. It will not be necessary to give the name of the animal, registry number or name of sire and dam until the certificates of registry are presented to the superintendents. **Health papers are required; please check the Animal Health Regulations for complete details.**
2. It is not necessary to identify the animals at time of entry, but the registration certificates are required at check-in. Health papers are required; please check Animal Health Regulations for complete details.
3. All goats must be registered in the respective flock books of the recognized Boer Goat Associations and bear such identification as that breed association requires at check-in. Goats not carrying such identification at validation shall be disqualified from competition.
4. The breeder of a goat is the owner of the dam at the time of service. Such a breeder must have his/her entries in his/her name and produce same registration certificates at check-in.
5. If an individual is showing a goat in the registered classes that is a gift from a breeder or if the goat has been purchased from some breeder the goat must be transferred and/or registered in the exhibitors name with the respective flock book of the respective recognized Boer Goat Associations on or before January 15 of the year preceding the show.
6. Partnerships will be accepted only if all partners are listed on the registration certificate and all partners are eligible. Partnership entries must remain as partnerships. Partners cannot show in individual classes.
7. Percentage females, full blood males and full blood female goats will be classed by birth date on certificate of registration. If birth date falls on date of show, goat will be moved to next upper age class.
8. Exhibitors are not allowed to enter more than three head per class in any division, but may only receive premiums on two per class.
9. The judge making awards must have the clerk record ear number, ear tag or tattoo of all animals awarded prizes.
10. Heelers will be allowed in the class.
11. The fitting of hair of all animals will be left up to the discretion of the exhibitor: with the exception of artificial color and the use of drugs and/or chemicals that are not approved by the FDA or USDA. If an exhibitor's animal is found to have been dyed, the said animal will be disqualified from the show and the said exhibitor will be barred from future shows. Goats may be clipped after arrival.
12. Goats may be washed after arrival. Facilities are available for washing goats in the swine area.
13. Pen assignments will be made by pen stewards at time of arrival. One pen will be assigned per two entries.

14. All goats must be removed from the barn after the show unless retained for exhibit.
15. Exhibitors must kid proof their own pens. Materials will not be provided for this.
16. Rosettes will be awarded to the first place in each class.
