

San Angelo Stock Show 2010 Show Updates, Changes & Reminders

Junior Market Steer Show

The Steer Show is under major changes for the 2010 year! We have decided to not have an “official weigh” in and allow exhibitors to turn in their own weight cards. This will additionally cut a day out of the show. Steers will arrive starting at 8:00 a.m., Thursday, February 25, 2010 and must be in place by 5:00 p.m., Thursday, February 25. Weight cards will be due at 6:00 p.m., Thursday, February 25. Please remember to arrive early to ensure you will have plenty of time to unload your animals, check-in and correctly fill out your weight cards. Please be extremely careful when filling out weight cards to select the correct breed, write in the exact and correct validation number and show weight.

The show will take place at 9:00 a.m., Friday, February 26. The show will be moving to the Spur Arena this year. The first class of steers will be called to the classifying area 30 minutes prior to the onset of the show. Classification will occur in the Cattle Arena. The exhibitors and cattle will then be transferred to the Spur Arena holding area, and then on to the show ring. Please keep in mind, this will be a constant flow from classifying, to holding to showing, so please be ready at least 30-45 minutes before your class goes in the actual show ring. Parents and agents will not be allowed in the classifying area. 1st and 2nd place will be weighed back in each class and the Superintendent of the show and Show Management reserve the right to weigh back any animal.

Remember: All 1st and 2nd place steers MUST sell in the premium sale. Jim Bloomberg of Berwick, Illinois will be judging again.

Junior Market Barrow Show:

The scheduling of the barrow show will remain as it was in 2009 with a three day show. All barrows will come in on Wednesday, February 24 and weight cards will be due that evening at 6. We will show Hampshire and Crossbred barrows starting at 8:00 a.m., Thursday, February 25 and all remaining barrows will show on Friday, February 26. The only change in the barrow show this year is the class set-up. There will still be five classes of Hampshires, six classes of Crossbreds, four classes of Durocs, however, this year we are implementing a “floating class” that will affect the Yorkshire, Black OPB and White OPB breed divisions. Those three breed divisions will each be guaranteed three classes a piece; however, there will be one additional class offered to the breed with the most weighed in entries. This will not change the number of barrows in the premium sale and is not an additional class offered from last year, it is simply restructuring the classes in those breeds to benefit the most exhibitors.

Remember: All barrows must be Texas bred and have a Texas Bred Certificate. Certificates are available from the breeder of the pig. The judge for the barrow show this year will be Ben Olsen of Irene, South Dakota.

Junior Market Lamb Show:

The only major change regarding to the lamb show is the scheduling. Lambs and Goats will all arrive on Saturday, February 20, 2010. We will start receiving lambs and goats at 7:00 a.m. on Saturday and they must all be in place by 5:00 p.m. Lamb weight cards are due at 7:00 p.m., Saturday, February 20, 2010. All lambs will show on Sunday, February 21 starting at 8:00 a.m.

Remember: All lambs must be Texas bred and have a Texas Lamb Breeder's Association tag to be eligible. These tags are available from the breeder of the lamb. Allen Hybsha from Binger, Oklahoma will be judging the show for us again this year.

Junior Wether Goat Show:

The only change for the wether goat show is the scheduling as well. Wether goats will follow the same arrival schedule and show schedule and the lambs. We will receive goats from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Saturday, February 20. All goat weight cards will be due at 6:00 p.m., Saturday, February 20. All goats will show on Sunday, February 21 starting at 8:00 a.m.

Reid Stultz of San Angelo, Texas will be judging the 2010 Junior Wether Goat Show.

NEW CONTESTS:

We are extremely excited to be adding two new events to the 2010 Livestock Show. We will have a Consumer Decision Making Contest on Monday, February 22 in the Fiesta Building. Registration will start at 8:00 a.m., with orientation at 9:00 a.m. and awards at 2:00 p.m. For a complete set of rules for this contest please check the Premium Book.

We are also adding a Public Speaking Contest which will take place Wednesday, February 24. Registration will begin at 8 a.m. with the contest beginning at 9:00 a.m. The final round will take place at 1 p.m. and awards will be at 3. Again, for complete listing of rules please see the Premium Book.

Junior Heifer Show:

The scheduling and rules for the Junior Heifer Show are going to remain the same they were in 2010 with a change only occurring to the scheduling of the Junior Maine Anjou Heifer Show. This show will take place on Saturday, February 20 at 6:00 p.m. Please see the Premium Book for complete details on arrival, release and registration times.

Remember: We currently only have shows for the following breeds: Angus, Brangus, Hereford, Maine Anjou, Mainetainer, Red Angus, Shorthorn, Simmental and Simbrah. Greg McCurry from Kansas will be judging the heifer show again in 2010. Please remember all shows are "blow and show" only!

Junior Breeding Gilts:

The only change facing the gilt show is the scheduling. We will receive gilts on Monday, February 22 from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. All gilts must register by 7:00 p.m. on Monday evening. The show will begin immediately following the CTBR Texas Stars Gilt Show.

Remember: All gilts must have health papers. Please check the Animal Health Regulations for a complete listing of requirements. This show is set-up on a six breed format: Duroc, Hampshire, Yorkshire, Spots, White OPB and Black OPB. The gilts will be judged by Chuck Real from Marion, Texas.

Junior Rabbit Show:

The rabbits are moving! We will still have the rabbit show on Friday, February 26 but they will be moving from the Spur Arena to the cattle arena. This area will still allow exhibitors easy access to the arena for loading and unloading. All rules will stay the same. The judge for 2010 is Carol Hooks of Moody, Texas.

Junior Angora Goat Show:

There are no rule changes for the Junior Angora Goat Show only a change in scheduling. We will start receiving sheep and goats on Wednesday, February 17 at 8:00 a.m. Entries for the Junior Angora Goat Show must be in place by 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, February 18. All goats must be checked in by 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, February 18. The show will take place on Friday, February 19 at 1:00 p.m. The Junior Angora Goat Show will be judged by John Allen of Del Rio, Texas.

Junior Angora Wether Futurity:

The only change for the Junior Angora Wether Futurity is the scheduling. We will start receiving sheep and goats on Wednesday, February 17 at 8:00 a.m. Entries for the Junior Angora Wether Futurity must be in place by 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, February 18. Weigh in will occur at 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, February 18. The show will take place on Friday, February 19 at 8:00 a.m. The judge will be Brian Faris of Westmoreland, Kansas.

Junior Breeding Sheep Show:

There is one major rule change for the 2010 Jr. Breeding Sheep Show! We will be requiring that all junior breeding sheep be validated with the State 4-H and FFA Lamb Validation program. This will also change the ownership date to October 1, 2009. Please remember to have all registration papers in the exhibitors name by October 1. The schedule for these entries has changed as well. We will start receiving Jr. Breeding Sheep at 8:00 a.m. on Wednesday, February 17 and they must be in place by 12:00 p.m. (Noon) on Friday, February 19. All entries must be checked in by 12:00 p.m. (Noon) on Friday, February 19. The Jr. Breeding Sheep Show will take place on Friday, February 19 at 5:00 p.m. and will show in the following order: Rambouillet, Delaine and Dorper.

Remember: Only Rambouillet, Delaine and Dorper breed divisions. All sheep are aged by teeth. The judge will be Marvin Ensor of San Angelo, Texas.

Junior Ewe Lamb Futurity:

The only change regarding the Ewe Lamb Futurity is the scheduling. Entries may be brought onto the grounds starting at 8:00 a.m. on Wednesday, February 17 and must be in place by 8:00 a.m., Thursday, February 18. All entries must weigh in at 8:00 a.m. on Thursday, February 18 at which time the show will also begin. Awards will take place on Sunday, February 21 at noon during the Market Lamb show. Judges will be Marvin Ensor, Pat Jackson and Dr. Gil Engdahl. If you need record book information please contact the Stock Show Office with your name and mailing address and we will be glad to get one to you.

CTBR Texas Stars Gilt Show:

With this being only the second year for this show we are extremely excited about the growth potential for this show. We will receive these gilts at the same time as the others, from 8 a.m. until 6 p.m. on Monday, February 22. All purebred gilts must have papers checked by 7 p.m. on Monday and crossbred gilt weight cards are due at 7 p.m. on Monday as well. The CTBR Gilt Show will start at 7:30 a.m., Tuesday, February 23 with the purebred division, followed immediately by the crossbred division. After the sale order is decided for the gilts, all gilts in the sale must have pictures taken.

Remember: This show is for Texas Bred gilts only, and all entries must have a Certified Texas Bred Registry Certificate. All gilts must have health papers; for more information, please visit the Animal Health Regulations page. This show is set-up to have an eight breed format depending on the number of entries. For more information regarding format please visit the rules in the Premium Book. If selected for the sale, gilts MUST sell. The judge will be Will Winter of Idalou, Texas.

Youth Boer Goat Show:

This show has no changes except for date. This show will move from the last weekend of the show to the beginning of the show. We will start receiving Boer goats at 8:00 a.m., on Wednesday, February 17 and they must be in place by 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, February 18. All Boer goats must be checked in by 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, February 18. The Show will begin at 8:00 a.m., on Friday, February 19. The judge will be Brad Roeder of Fredericksburg, Texas.

Remember: This show is open to exhibitors under the age of 19, as of January 1, 2010.

Judging Contests:

The only contest that will experience any change is the Livestock Judging Contest. This year we will be adding a class of goats to the contest. For the schedule of judging contests please see 2010 Livestock Schedule.

The Wildlife Judging Contest entry deadline is December 1, 2009, for no late fee.

Ag Mechanics Show:

The Ag Mechanics show will add another division for the 2010 year. This year we will add a Horse Drawn Equipment division and there will be two classes within the division. For a complete listing of classes and rules see the Premium Book.

Entry Deadlines:

- All Junior Entries: Must be entered online and forms and payment postmarked by December 1, 2009.
- Late Junior Entries: Postmarked between December 2- December 15, 2009. Double entry fee will be applied.
- Rabbit Entries: Market Rabbit entries must be postmarked by January 31, 2010 and Breeding Rabbit Entries must be postmarked by January 5, 2010.
- Late Judging Contest Entries: Judging Contests entries will be accepted up to the day of the show for double entry fees in cash only.
- All Open Entries: Forms and payments must be postmarked by January 15, 2010.
- Late Open Entries: Postmarked between January 16 and January 31, 2010. Double entry fees will be applied.
- Additional Late Entries: Junior Show entries not postmarked prior to December 15 and Open Show entries not postmarked by January 31 will be accepted up to the closing of check-in for any show for a \$200 fee.

OTHER IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENTS:

-Online Entries: We will be using the ShoWorks online entry system again in 2010. Any students entered last year, should be in the system already, please call if you do not remember their passwords.

-Premium Book: The Premium Book has completely been rewritten for the 2010 year. It is extremely important that exhibitors, parents and/or guardians, and AST's/CEA's are familiar with the General Rules and Junior Rules (if applicable). Also, please remember you are responsible for knowing the specific rules for the show you are entering.

-Entry Forms: Even if entering through the online system a paper entry form must be submitted for all exhibitors. Signatures must be originals (not stamps or photocopies). Junior Entries must be signed by a parent/guardian and an advisor.

-Pay-Out Schedule: The Junior Breeding Sheep Show, Junior Angora Goat Show, Youth Boer Goat Show, Open Breeding Sheep Show and Open Boer Goat Show will all follow a sliding scale pay-out. For more information on this pay-out see the Show Rules in the Premium Book.

-Entry Deadline for Open Show: The entry deadline for the open shows was postponed to January 15, 2010.
