1. Any FFA Chapter or County 4-H Club in Texas may enter as many teams as they wish. Any Team or individuals eligible for competition in the state contests are eligible to judge in this contest. Students that comprise each team are to be members of that 4-H County or FFA Chapter. Entry must be made on an official entry form furnished by the San Angelo Stock Show.
2. Teams will consist of four members. The scores of the three (3) high scoring team members will count as the team's score with the low scoring member automatically becoming the alternate. Alternates and individual scores can be counted for individual awards.
3. Scan sheets will be provided by the San Angelo Stock Show & Rodeo Association.
4. There will be an FFA division and a 4-H division. The 4-H division will consist of junior and senior sections.
5. The senior 4-H contestants will give two sets of oral reasons; one set on halter class and one set on performance class. Contestants shall be notified of the classes that reasons will be taken on. Junior 4-H contestants will not give oral reasons. FFA contestants will answer a set of ten questions. Questions will come from the 4-H reasons classes.
6. Eight classes will be judged, consisting of four halter classes and four performance classes. Classes will be presented as to availability of quality animals.
7. Ties will be broken based on high reasons scores on individual and teams.
8. Plaques will be awarded to the top 3 teams in the FFA division, Sr. 4-H division, and Jr. 4-H division. Plaques will also be awarded to the top 5 individuals in the FFA division, Sr. 4-H division, and Jr. 4-H division.
9. High point individuals in FFA and 4-H Senior divisions will receive a \$500.00 incentive made payable to the individual to be mailed by the end of April. Checks will be mailed to the 4-H or FFA Club through which they entered. Individuals are eligible for multiple incentives.
