1. All rules apply to the Junior Texas Stars Doe Show. Please refer to the General Rules and Junior Show Rules.
2. To be eligible to exhibit in the 2012 Junior Texas Stars Doe Show, does must be validated in the Texas 4-H and FFA Wether Goat Validation Program. Hair follicle samples will be collected from the first place doe in each class.  
The Junior Texas Stars Doe Show Committee and Show Management may also collect hair follicle samples from any other doe entry for the purpose of conducting a DNA analysis. Any doe not having a positive match from the DNA analysis of this hair follicle sample, compared to the DNA analysis of the hair follicle sample taken from it at the time of enrollment in the validation program, will be disqualified.
3. All entries must be owned and the bona fide project of a boy or girl, regularly enrolled in a Texas 4-H Club or FFA Chapter, by October 31, of the year preceding the show, and must have been personally fed and cared for under the supervision of a County Agent or Teacher of Vocational Agriculture.
4. Health papers along with other testing will be required. Please check Animal Health Regulations for the 2012 Stock Show for complete requirements for all does exhibited in the 2012 Show. Health papers must be submitted to show officials at check-in when papers are checked or weights are turned in, whichever is applicable.  
Animal Health Regulations for Does
  1. All certificates must be issued on or after January 22, 2012, with the following information:
    - A. Sexually intact animals must have official USDA Scrapie Eradication Program Identification.
5. There is a limit of three entries per exhibitor.
6. Goats will be stalled in the Livestock Barn #2. Enter Gate 2 and unload on the West side of the building. Pens will be assigned upon arrival. To pen with someone, you must arrive together – no holding of pens will be allowed.
7. Exhibitors are responsible for turning in correct weight on an official weight card to be submitted in its entirety to show personnel. Superintendents will break classes immediately following the weigh-in. Classes will be broken into no more than 9 weight classes in three divisions. **The number of classes is up to the discretion of the committee and show officials based on the number of entries.** There will be no pre-set weight breaks.
8. Does must weigh a minimum of 50 pounds and there is no maximum. Only does may be shown.

9. The Doe Show Superintendent has the right to weigh any entry at any time. Goats will be designated for re-weighing during the judging. Any entry weighing more than 5 pounds above or below the initial official show weight will become ineligible for any award or premium sale.
10. At the time of show, does must not possess more than their first set of yearling teeth.
11. Dehorning of the goats is not suggested, however, horns should be tipped and rounded. Goats with horns sharper than deemed safe by the show superintendent or Show Management will be required to be tipped or rounded or the animal will be isolated and not shown.
12. This is a "Blow and Go" show. Blocking tables and blowers will be permitted. Battery powered clippers will be allowed for touch-ups only. All does must be clipped prior to arrival. Hair length of the animal is left up to the discretion of the exhibitor.
13. No painting, powdering, or artificial coloring is allowed.
14. No electrical equipment of any kind is allowed. HAY, HEAT LAMPS, ICE PACKS, OR PROPANE HEATERS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED IN THE BARNES!!
16. GOATS MAY BE WASHED AFTER ARRIVAL.
17. No external parasites will be allowed. If a goat is found to have external parasites, it will be disqualified.
18. All division champions and reserve champions and all Top 5 scholarship does will be subject to DNA and Substance testing. The Show specifically reserves the right to have ultrasound, D.N.A., tissue, blood and/or urine laboratory analysis made on any animal entered for competition. The exhibitor, including his or her parent or guardian or AST or CEA for Junior exhibitors, must be present during the collection for testing and must witness, seal and sign the sample; thus verifying the sample to be properly collected and prepared for analysis.
19. All division champions and reserve champions will be automatically eligible for the sale. However, a division champion or reserve is NOT guaranteed a top 5 Scholarship.
20. The judge will select 10 preliminary sale candidates from each division. Any does selected as preliminary candidates must remain at the show and will be called back to determine sale order. A preliminary selection is no guarantee the animal will make the sale.
21. The judge will select 20 animals to sale and any and all animals selected must be sold. There is no limit to the number of entries an exhibitor may sell.
22. Scholarships will be awarded pending results of all DNA and Drug Testing results. To be awarded the scholarship, DNA tests must confirm a positive match and Drug tests must confirm negative for any and all residues.
23. Exhibitors must be present and exhibiting their animal to receive the scholarship. All other rules of the San Angelo Stock Show and Rodeo Breeding Livestock Show Scholarships are applicable to contestants in this show.
