1. All rules apply to the Junior Angus Heifer Show. Please refer to the General Rules and Junior Show Rules.
2. All animals to be eligible to show must be recorded in the American Angus Association Record. Exhibitors must file with the Stock Show Office the name and herd book of each animal entered.
3. All exhibitors must have owned the heifers shown in the name continuously since November 1, 2011, and the official registration certificate must indicate that the exhibitor was the sole owner of the heifer on or before November 1, 2011 and that the registration certificate was processed by the American Angus Association on or before November 1, 2011.
4. To be eligible to show, all heifers must have been calved after September 1, 2009. Only Black Angus are allowed in this show.
5. There is no limit on the number of heifers an exhibitor may show, however, all animals must be registered in the exhibitor's name.
6. **THIS IS A NON-FIT SHOW. BLOW & SHOW ONLY!** Do not use black paint, glue or other adhesives on your heifers. Keep it simple and your work will be less and the heifers will love you for it. See the American Angus Association's statement on the use of products from aerosol cans.
7. Substitutions of heifers already entered may be made as long as the substituted heifer conforms to all rules applying to this show.
8. All exhibitors are eligible to compete for a Junior or Senior Showmanship award. Exhibitors 13 years old or younger on January 1, 2012, will be eligible to compete for Jr. Showmanship, and exhibitors 14 years old or older on January 1, 2012 will be eligible to compete for Sr. Showmanship.
9. If any classes have an excessive number of entries, they will be divided into two or more classes according to American Angus Association guidelines.
10. All exhibitors will be issued a show number for each heifer entered in the show, and no heifer will be allowed in the show ring to be judged unless the exhibitor leading the heifer is wearing the number assigned to the heifer being shown.
11. Exhibitors entering this show are eligible to enter the All Breed Junior Heifer Futurity. However, entry to the Futurity requires separate designation on the entry form, as well as, additional entry fees. Exhibitors are NOT automatically entered into the Futurity.
12. An animal that is disqualified for ANY REASON in its respective breed show will be disqualified from the Heifer Futurity, as well. Additionally, the exhibitor will be required to forfeit any premiums, ribbons and/or any other prizes won in the Futurity Show, but in no event shall it affect the order of finish of any of the other animals competing in the Futurity Show.

13. The exhibitor of the Grand Champion Angus Heifer will receive a \$500.00 incentive. The exhibitor of the Reserve Champion Angus Heifer will receive a \$250.00 incentive. Incentive recipients may enter future shows and may receive another incentive. Exhibitors must be present and exhibiting their own animal to be awarded the scholarship.

The American Angus Association, 3201 Frederick Avenue, St. Joseph, MO, will participate in premiums offered in individual classes for Junior Angus heifers, as included in its standard show classifications, according to the premium schedule based on the number of head shown. The Association's contributions will be included in the premium checks issued by the show.

A minimum of fifteen (15) head must be shown in the Junior Angus heifer classes to receive American Angus Association premium participation. The show is not required to have all classes to be eligible for premiums. Separate classes for bred and owned heifers may be held if the size of the show merits a separate class.

To be eligible for association premiums, the entries must be recorded in the sole name of the junior exhibitor and the issue date on the registration certificate must conform to the individuals show's requirements regarding ownership. The Association's contribution is included in the total premiums listed in each class. Premiums from the Association are paid only to registered Angus cattle and only if the registration number is a part of the show report provided to the Association. Therefore, all cattle should be registered at the time of entry to make certain they receive the Association's portion of premiums. The Association does not pay a percentage on premiums offered in the championship classes. An animal may only be counted one time toward the total count for premium participation by the Association.

Exhibitors must have the original registration certificate on each animal available for inspection at the show.

Any animal, upon check-in, which does not have a legible permanent identification mark (ear tattoo marks, freeze-branded marks or hot-branded marks) corresponding to the permanent identification mark on the registration certificate, is ineligible to show. Once disqualified due to an incorrect or illegible permanent identification mark, animals cannot be re-tattooed and rechecked at the show.

When any female is shown with a calf at side, the calf must be the cow's most recent natural calf, and the calf must be registered by show date and have the original registration certificate at check in.

Only one person at a time shall lead animals into the show ring.

Any product administered internally or used externally to alter the conformation and/or appearance of an animal for exhibition is prohibited. This includes the covering of white skin, false tail heads (or use of any false hair); use of graphite, powders, hemp or other similar substances exhibition of cattle displaying false hair will not be allowed, with the exception of false tail switches.

For an exhibitor to be eligible at shows for premium monies contributed by the American Angus Association, each exhibitor is subject to Part 3, Section IX of the Association's rules entitled "Eligibility, Conformation, and Structure of Animals Presented for Exhibition." Included in this is Rule 11: "Effective July 1, 2004, at any show for which the American Angus Association appropriates funds toward the payment of premiums, no exhibitors, individuals assisting exhibitors or member owners at such show shall be allowed to use any coloring agents on any animal exhibited." The Association may adopt and implement various tests designed to monitor this prohibition, including but not limited to a "white towel" or "white glove" text. No aerosol cans or other pressurized containers will be allowed in designated make up areas.

DNA marker or blood type for parentage verification – Under Association Rules each animal, for which entry application (registration) is received, may be subjected to a DNA marker type or blood type test to verify ACCURACY OF PARENTAGE as covered under Association Rules. Staff of the American Angus Association must supervise the collection of DNA or blood samples. Animals are often sampled at shows, fairs, or events where the American Angus Association contributes premiums or where Association personnel participate.

If a recorded parent is excluded (as a parent) as a result of DNA or blood type, the owner may request, at his own expense, the Association to determine the actual parent. Failure to determine the sire and dam disqualifies the animal's eligibility in the Angus Herd Book and the registration certificate becomes null and void.
