1. All rules apply to the Brangus Heifer Show. Please refer to the General Rules and Junior Show Rules.
2. All animals to be eligible to show must be recorded in the Brangus Association Record. Exhibitors must file with the stock show Office name and herd book of each animal entered.
3. The exhibitor showing must have owned the animal(s) shown on or before January 1, 2012, and registry records so reflect.
4. To be eligible to show, the heifers must have been calved after January 1, 2010.
5. There is no limit on the number of heifers an exhibitor may show, however, all animals must be registered in the exhibitor's name.
6. BLOW & SHOW ONLY! No paint or adhesives allowed!
7. No animal may be shown that has scurs or any indication of scurs.
8. No animal may be shown that shows evidence of brindle.
9. Exhibitors will be required to follow the dress code while exhibiting their animal. Exhibitors must show in dark pants that are not torn or have holes and a white button down shirt that must be tucked in.
10. Exhibitors entered this show are eligible to enter the All Breed Junior Heifer Futurity. However, entry to the Futurity requires separate designation on the entry form, as well as, additional entry fees. Exhibitors are NOT automatically entered into the Futurity.
11. An animal that is disqualified for ANY REASON, in its respective breed show will be disqualified from the Heifer Futurity, as well. Additionally, the exhibitor will be required to forfeit any premiums, ribbons, and/or any other prizes won in the Futurity Show, but in no event shall it affect the order of finish of any of the other animals competing in the Futurity Show. This rule applies to all entries regardless to the time of the breed show in regards to the time of the Futurity Show.
12. The exhibitor of the Grand champion Brangus Heifer will receive a \$500.00 incentive. The exhibitor of the Reserve Champion Brangus Heifer will receive a \$250.00 incentive. Incentive recipients may enter future shows and may receive another incentive. Exhibitors must be present and exhibiting their own animal to be awarded the incentive.
