JUNIOR BREEDING SHEEP SHOW

1. All rules apply to the Junior Breeding Sheep Show. Please refer to the General Rules and Junior Show Rules.
2. Each entry form must show the full name, address, and social security number of the exhibitor, the name of the breed and number of head entered. It will not be necessary to give the name of the animal, registry number or name of sire and dam until the certificate of registry is presented to the superintendent. Certificates of registry must be furnished to the superintendent before the animals enter the ring. Affidavits in lieu of registration certificates will not be accepted.
3. All breeding sheep must be registered in the Flock Books of their respective breeds, and bear such identification as that association requires, by October 1, 2011. Sheep not carrying ear tags or tattoos at time of showing will be barred from competition.
4. To be eligible to exhibit in the 2012 Junior Breeding Sheep Show, all sheep must be validated in the Texas 4-H and FFA Breeding Sheep Validation Program. Hair follicle samples will be collected from all Breed Champions and all Reserve Champions, and a DNA analysis will be conducted on each of these hair follicle samples. The Junior Breeding Sheep Show committee may also collect hair follicle samples from any other entry for the purpose of conducting a DNA analysis. Any sheep not having a positive match from the DNA analysis of the hair follicle samples, compared to the DNA analysis of the hair follicle sample taken from it at the time of enrollment in the validation program, will be disqualified. Nose prints will also be taken on all sheep at validation and those prints may be verified at the show. All breeding sheep will be validated in individual exhibitor names and not by families. No partnerships allowed.
5. The breeder of an animal is the owner of the dam at the time of service. If a boy or girl showing sheep in the registered class is such a breeder, his or her lamb must be registered in the boy's or girl's name by opening day of the show.
6. If a boy or a girl is showing a sheep in the registered classes that is a gift from some breeder, the transfer certificate must be dated on Association records on or before October 1, of the year preceding the show.
7. Classes are provided for lambs and two-tooth sheep. Sheep in the Lamb Classes must retain all lamb teeth and be at least 6 months of age. Sheep which have dropped one or more milk teeth, or show one or both teeth of the permanent pair of incisors, are eligible only in the Two-Tooth Classes. Sheep with more than two visible permanent incisors will not be eligible to show in this division. In order to be able to move a ewe lamb or buck lamb up, you must fill the lamb class first.
8. Each junior exhibitor is entitled to enter four (4) Rams and four (4) Ewes in each breed division in the Junior Breeding Show; however, each exhibitor may show only two (2) Rams or two (2) Ewes in each single class and one group in each group class.
9. The judge making awards must have the clerk record the ear tag number of each animal awarded a prize.
10. Only first place winners shall compete for champion animal. The second place winner in the class from which the champion animal was selected will compete for reserve champion animal.

11. Pen assignments will be made by the pen stewards at time of arrival. One pen will be assigned per two entries.
12. The same sheep MAY compete in both Junior and Open Shows.
13. Livestock exhibitors will be allowed to display signs over exhibits advertising their own herds. This is only allowed in livestock barns.
14. No unloading on the East side of the barns.
15. All sheep entered in the Junior Rambouillet Show must be shorn on or after October 20th of the year preceding the show. No boots. Fleece length must be uniform over body.
16. Dorpers and White Dorpers will show together.
17. The exhibitor of the Grand Champion Rambouillet Ewe, Delaine Ewe and Dorper Ewe will receive a \$500.00 incentive. The exhibitor of the Reserve Grand Champion Rambouillet Ewe, Delaine Ewe and Dorper Ewe will receive a \$250.00 incentive. Incentive recipients may enter future shows and may receive another incentive. Exhibitors must be present to be awarded the incentive.
18. Pay-Out. Checks will be mailed to the agent/instructor following the show.
