## JUNIOR ALL BREED HEIFER FUTURITY

Entry Fee:	\$15.00 per head – Limit 1 per exhibitor Heifer must be entered in the Angus, Brangus, <b>Chianina</b> , Hereford, <b>Limousin</b> , Maine-Anjou, Red Angus, Shorthorn or Simmental/Simbrah Shows
Entry Deadline:	December 1, 2011 Postmark (Double fees Dec. 1- Show Check In)

1. All rules apply to the Heifer Futurity. Please refer to the General Rules and Junior Show Rules.
2. Trophies and prizes will be furnished.
3. Judging will be done by recognized livestock judges and breeders.
4. Each exhibitor may enter only one heifer in the futurity. Each contestant must show the animals they enter, as well as own the animal they exhibit. Heifer must be entered and shown in its respective breed at San Angelo. **Two trophy buckles will be presented: one for the high scoring contestant over 13, and one for the high scoring contestant 13 or under. Ages are broken by date of birth on January 1 the year of the show.**
5. Four places split 20%, 15%, 10% and 5% will be paid to the top four winners in each age division from the total of entries.

PREMIUM CHECKS WILL BE MAILED TO THE AGENT/INSTRUCTOR FOLLOWING THE SHOW.

6. If tie scores occur, tie will be broken by using reasons score first, then showmanship, judging and sales talk.
7. The Heifer Futurity point system is as follows:

A. Showmanship	50 points possible
B. Judging of two heifer classes	50 points possible
C. Reasons for judging class	50 points possible
D. Sales talk by the exhibitors	50 points possible
8. All entries must conform to the rules and regulations of their respective breed and the San Angelo Stock Show and Rodeo Association. The Heifer Futurity section of the Junior Heifer Entry Form must be filled out listing the breed.
9. Showmanship will be judged as a special class and points will be awarded to each contestant. Primary considerations will be presentation of the animal and show it to best advantage. Two classes of heifers will be judged and oral reasons given on one class. Judging contest will follow the 4-H & FFA contest rules. The sales talk is judged on the ability of contestants to “sell” their heifer to the judge. The judge is given the registration certificate for information and will interact with contestant. Heifer may be held by another person while contestant is giving his presentation. The sales talk should take about 5 minutes.
10. An animal that is disqualified for ANY REASON, in its respective breed show will be disqualified from the Heifer Futurity, as well. Additionally, the exhibitor will be required to forfeit any premiums, ribbons and/or any other prizes won in the Futurity Show, but in no event shall it affect the order of finish of the other animals competing in the Futurity Show.
