1. All rules apply to the Junior Maine-Anjou Heifer Show. Please refer to the General Rules and Junior Show Rules.
2. All heifers to must be registered in the AMAA Record Book and be at least 75% Maine-Anjou.
3. All exhibitors must have owned the heifers shown in their name continuously since December 1, 2011, and the official registration certificate must indicate that the exhibitor was the sole owner of the heifer on or before December 1st.
4. To be eligible to show, the heifers must have been calved after September 1, 2009.
5. There is no limit on the number of heifers an exhibitor may show, however, all animals must be registered in the exhibitor's name.
- 6. BLOW & SHOW ONLY! No paint or adhesives may be used!**
7. Heifer tattoo's must be legible and must match the registration papers exactly. Tattoo's will be verified at check-in.
8. Faxes and copies of registration certificates will not be accepted.
9. Exhibitors entering this show are eligible to enter the All Breed Junior Heifer Futurity. However, entry to the Futurity requires separate designation on the entry form, as well as, additional entry fees. Exhibitors are NOT automatically entered into the Futurity.
10. An animal that is disqualified for ANY REASON, in its respective breed show will be disqualified from the Heifer Futurity, as well. Additionally, the exhibitor will be required to forfeit any premiums, ribbons, and/or any other prizes won in the Futurity Show, but in no event shall it affect the order of finish of any of the other animals competing in the Futurity Show. This rule applies to all entries regardless to the time of the breed show in regards to the time of the Futurity Show.
11. The exhibitor of the Grand Champion Maine-Anjou Heifer will receive a \$500.00 incentive. The exhibitor of the Reserve Champion Maine-Anjou Heifer will receive a \$250.00 incentive. Incentive recipients may enter future shows and may receive another incentive. Exhibitors must be present and exhibiting their own animal to be awarded the incentive.
