Entry Fee:	\$10.00 per pen of 3 in class 1 – No limit on entries \$3.00 per rabbit in classes 2 - 11 – No limit on entries
Entry Deadline:	All – January 31, 2012 (postmarked on or before)

1. All rules apply to the Junior Rabbit Show. Please refer to the General Rules and Junior Show Rules.
2. All exhibitors must check in between 7:30 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. Substitutions will be allowed only in the Commercial and Fancy division between 7:30 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. Substitutions may only be made if the animals are within the same breed, sex and class and will not be accepted after the show begins. There will be a \$1.00 charge for substitution. No changes or substitutions will be allowed in the Market Division.
3. Exhibits are to remain in place until the show is over; not later than 5:00 p.m. After the show, exhibits leaving the grounds must have a written release from the superintendent. Exhibitors are to remain with their exhibits until the show is over.
4. There will be a designated area for exhibitors, staff, and Superintendents only. Parents may help exhibitors but **MAY NOT PLACE RABBITS ON TABLES**. The superintendents or staff will assist the exhibitors in doing this.
5. Each exhibitor will be responsible for furnishing carriers and waterers for their exhibits. Standard size 1, 2 or 3 hole carriers with bottoms (not larger than 24 x 24) are allowed. NO CAGES.
6. All rabbits **MUST** have a legible and permanent tattoo in the left ear and the tattoo **MUST** be sent with entry form at time of entry or entry will be disqualified. **ALL OF THE NUMBERS MUST BE LISTED ON THE ENTRY FORM EXACTLY AS TATOODED IN THE EAR. DO NOT DUPLICATE NUMBERS.** Trio Fryer entries **MUST** have three different numbers and be indicated as a trio entry on the entry form (Example D1, D2, D3). If tattoo is not readable and does not match entry card, entry will be disqualified.
7. No tattooing will be allowed on the fairgrounds. Entries will be disqualified- no exceptions.
8. Rabbits should be free of all disease symptoms. Rabbits showing signs of disease will not be allowed to show. Rabbits showing signs of sickness may be pulled at any time during the show by the superintendent only and at the superintendent's discretion. Any rabbit with symptoms of disease **MUST BE IMMEDIATELY REMOVED** from the barn.
9. Rabbits will be called to the table 3 times only, and then will be eliminated. Market entries will be weighed in, and then placed on the table.
10. Showmanship will be judged with each exhibitor asked to handle and present one rabbit for showing. There will be a junior and senior class buckle donated by Blair's Western Wear.
11. The Champion, Reserve Champion and 3rd Place Market Division Rabbits will not sell in the Premium Sale; however, will receive \$300, \$150, \$75 premium respectively.
12. Health papers are not required.
13. Rabbits will be shown in the 1st Community Credit Union Spur Arena. Exhibitors will need to enter at Gate 6 on 50th Street.

MARKET DIVISION

All rabbits will be weighed the day of the show.

Class 1 Trio Fryer: Trios from commercial breeds only must be the same color and not over 5 lbs. each. The whole pen will be disqualified if one rabbit is overweight or diseased. Anything over 5 lbs. or 70 days old will be disqualified.

ALL COMMERCIAL AND FANCY RABBITS WILL BE SHOWN BY BREED

COMMERCIAL DIVISION

Any ARBA recognized breed may enter. Examples of breeds previously shown:

Californian English Lop New Zealand Satin French Lop

Class 2 – Junior Buck.....6 months and younger
Class 3 – 6-8 Buck.....6 months – 8 months
Class 4 – Senior Buck.....over 8 months
Class 5 – Junior Doe.....6 months and younger
Class 6 – 6-8 Doe.....6 months – 8 months
Class 7 – Senior Doe.....over 8 months

FANCY DIVISION

Any ARBA recognized breed may enter. Examples of breeds previously shown:

Florida White Mini Lop Dutch Himalayan Holland Lop Rex

Class 8 – Junior Buck.....6 months and younger
Class 9 – Senior Buck.....over 6 months
Class 10 – Junior Doe.....6 months and younger
Class 11 – Senior Doe.....over 6 months

Trophies will be awarded to the Champion and Reserve Champion rabbits in all divisions.
Ribbons will be awarded for 1 – 10 in each class.

Two showmanship awards will be presented. One to a junior exhibitor and one to a senior exhibitor.
