1. All rules apply to the Junior Wether Goat Show. Please refer to the General Rules and Junior Show Rules.
2. To be eligible to exhibit in the 2012 Junior Wether Goat Show, a goat must be validated in the Texas 4-H and FFA Wether Goat Validation Program. Each entry must have been recorded on a Goat Validation Form between October 1 and October 31. Exhibitors must have owned and cared for the goats continuously since October 31, 2011.  
  
Hair follicle samples will be collected from the first place wether goat in each class. Should the Reserve Grand champion wether goat come out of the same class as the Grand Champion Wether Goat, then the second place class winner will also have hair follicle samples collected. The Wether Goat Committee may also collect hair follicle samples from any other wether goat entry for the purpose of conducting a DNA analysis. Any wether goat not having a positive match from the DNA analysis of this hair follicle sample, compared to the DNA analysis of the hair follicle sample taken from it at the time of enrollment in the validation program, will be disqualified.  
  
Validation tags will be used. A separate tag will not be issued.
3. Previous exhibitors of the Grand Champion Wether Goat are ineligible to enter the Junior Wether Goat Show.
4. Goats will be stalled in the Livestock Barn #2. Enter Gate 2 and unload on the West side of the building. Pens will be assigned upon arrival. To pen with someone, you must arrive together – no holding of pens will be allowed.
5. Exhibitors are responsible for turning in correct weight on official disposition form to be submitted in its entirety to show personnel, who will then give the exhibitor a portion back that will be required for placement on the truck. Superintendents will break classes immediately following the weigh-in. Classes will be broken into 10 weight classes. There will be no pre-set weight breaks.
6. Wether goats must weigh a minimum of 60 pounds and maximum of 115 pounds. Only wethers may be shown.
7. The Goat Show Superintendent has the right to weigh any entry at any time. Goats will be designated for re-weighting during the judging. Any entry weighing more or less than 4 pounds above or below the initial official show weight will become ineligible for any award or premium sale and may be assessed a \$10 cwt penalty.
8. There is no tooth rule.
9. Wethers must be UNIFORMLY shorn 3/8" or less above the knee and hock joints before arrival on the grounds. NO clipping will be allowed on the grounds. Removal of horns on grounds is not permitted. No sharp points allowed on horns.
10. No painting, powdering, or artificial coloring is allowed.

11. No electrical equipment of any kind is allowed. Hay, heat lamps, ice packs, or propane heaters will not be allowed in the barns.
12. The only tags goats may have in their ears are state validation tags. All others must be removed.
13. Goats may be washed after arrival
14. No external parasites will be allowed. If a goat is found to have external parasites, it will be disqualified.
15. Exhibitors are responsible for confining and keeping their animals in the assigned pens. The San Angelo Stock Show and Rodeo Association will not be held responsible for any animals getting out of the assigned pens. No panels will be available.
16. The Junior Wether Goat show is a terminal show. All entries arriving at the show must be sold (including sifted, non-placing and ribbon winning wether goats). In the event the San Angelo Stock Show is unable to obtain an adequate packer bid, the animals will remain in the possession of the exhibitor and must be removed from the fairgrounds according to the release time established by the show.
17. All animals that qualify for the sale must sell in the Premium Sale and will not receive any additional premium monies.
18. The following premium schedule has been established and will be provided for places 5-8 in each weight class.
19. Health papers are not required.
