1. Any FFA Chapter or County 4-H Club in Texas may enter as many teams as they wish. Any Team or individuals eligible for competition in the state contests are eligible to judge in this contest. Students that comprise each team are to be members of that 4-H County or FFA Chapter. Entry must be made on an official entry form furnished by the San Angelo Stock Show.
2. Contest will be divided into two (2) divisions: Junior (ages 8-13) and Senior (ages: 14-19).
3. Competing teams will consist of four members and the scores of the three high scoring team members will count as the team's score with the low scoring member automatically becoming the alternate. The alternate's score can be counted for individual awards.
4. Eight placing classes for both divisions will be judged. These classes will represent each species (cattle, sheep, swine and goats). Both the senior and junior division will answer 3 sets of questions.
5. Scan sheets will be provided by the San Angelo Stock Show & Rodeo Association.
6. Contestants will be allowed 12 minutes on each class to make their observations, record their placings, and take notes for questions when applicable. Handling of animals will be left up to the discretion of contest committee. Contestants will be notified two minutes before the placing class time is up.
7. Ties will be broken by awarding the higher place to the individual or team scoring the highest in Beef total, Sheep total, Swine total and Goat total placings giving priority in the order listed.
8. Plaques will be awarded to the three highest scoring teams in the contest in each division. The 5 highest scoring individuals, in the senior division will receive awards with the High Point Senior Individual receiving a \$500.00 incentive and a plaque. The next 4 high scoring senior individuals will receive plaques. The 5 highest scoring individuals in the Junior Division will receive awards.
9. The High Point Individual receiving the \$500.00 incentive will be made payable to the individual and sent by the end of April to the 4-H or FFA club through which they entered.. Individuals are eligible for multiple incentives.
