1. All rules apply to the Open Breeding Sheep Show. Please refer to the General Rules and Junior Show Rules.
2. Each livestock entry card must contain full name, address, and social security number of exhibitor, the name of breed, and the number of head entered. It will not be necessary to give the name of the animal, registry number or name of sire and dam until the certificates of registry are presented to the superintendents. **Health papers are required; please check the Animal Health Regulations for complete details.**
3. All sheep will be judged according to the classification on Breed Association score card (breed standards).
4. All breeding sheep must be registered in the flock books of their respective breeds, and bear such identification as that breed association requires, before entering the ring. Sheep not carrying ear tags or tattoo at time of showing will be barred from competition.
5. The breeder of an animal is the owner of the dam at the time of service. If an individual showing sheep in the registered classes is such a breeder, the lamb must be registered in his/her name by opening day of the show.
6. If an individual is showing a sheep in the registered classes that is a gift from some breeder, or if the sheep has been purchased from some breeder, the transfer certificate must be dated on Association records on or before January 15 of the year preceding this show.
7. In the Rambouillet, Delaine, Columbia and Southdown shows, classes are provided for lambs, two-tooth sheep and four to six-tooth sheep. Sheep in the lamb classes must retain all lamb teeth and be at least 6 months of age. Sheep which have dropped one or more milk teeth, or show one or both teeth of the first permanent pair of incisors are eligible only on the two-tooth classes. Sheep showing the first two pair or three pair of permanent incisors are eligible to show in the four to six-tooth classes only. In order to be able to move a ewe lamb or buck lamb up, you must fill the class first.
8. In the Dorper show, classes are provided for lambs, yearling, and aged sheep. Dorpers will be classed by the birth date on the registration papers. If the birth date falls on the date of the show, sheep will be moved to the next older age class.
9. Each exhibitor may show three and place two entries in each single class but may show only one entry in a group class.
10. Any animal exhibited in a group class (i.e. a pair of Ram Lambs) must be entered in its respective class (i.e. Ram Lamb class) in the show, as well.
11. Pen assignments will be made by pen stewards at time of arrival. One pen will be assigned per two entries.
12. UNLOADING IN FRONT OF THE BARN IS PROHIBITED!

13. In the Delaine division, lambs and two-tooth sheep may be shown in full fleece. Four to six-tooth sheep must have been shorn with a machine, using Texas combs, over the entire body since March 15th of the year preceding the show.
14. All Rambouillet and Columbia sheep must be shorn on or after October 20th of the year preceding the show.
15. All Southdown and Dorper sheep must be slick shorn within one week prior to show. Foretops and boots may be left on Southdown sheep. Boots may be left on the Dorper sheep and all Dorper sheep must have docked tails.
16. There will be two Dorper sheep shows: 1) Dorper (white with black heads) and 2) White Dorper (all white), must indicate which show on entry forms. **All dorpers must be born on or after 1/1/2009.**
17. American purebred Dorper ewes must be at least 7/8 blood and will show with full blood South African ewes. American purebred Dorper rams must be at least 15/16 blood and will show with full blood South African rams.
18. The Open Dorper Sheep Show will be judged by an approved judge. The American Dorper sheep Breeders Society will furnish a list of approved judges to the show.
