ENTRY DEADLINE: January 15, 2012 postmark (Late entry between Jan. & Feb. for additional fee)

ARRIVAL TIME: Beginning at 1:00 p.m. on Friday, February 24, 2012 (or by arrangement with show management for early arrival). Enter through Gate 6 on the north side of the fairgrounds, off 50th Street.

IN PLACE: All llamas must be in place and checked in no later than 7:30 a.m. Saturday, February 25, 2012

TIME OF SHOW: Saturday, February 25, 2012
7:30 a.m., Exhibitor meeting with judge in Spur Arena
8:00 a.m., Youth Classes and Open Performance Classes
9:00 a.m., Sunday, February 26, 2012- Halter Classes

RELEASE: Immediately following the conclusion of the show Sunday, February 26, 2012- see show management for release

The South Central Llama Association sponsors this ALSA-sanctioned Level Two Llama Show.

1. This show is governed by the rules and regulations of the Alpaca and Llama Show Association (ALSA).
2. All llamas entering the show grounds must comply with the 16th edition ALSA Handbook and by the rules of the San Angelo Stock Show & Rodeo Association. Each exhibitor is responsible for being familiar with all rules as stated in the ALSA Handbook, which has any changes posted on the ALSA Web site.
3. Age of Animals is determined by the day the llama enters the show ring. All Youth ages are determined by January 1, 2012, except for eight year olds, who are eligible to show as of their 8th birthday.
4. All llamas 5 months and older entered in approved classes must be registered or have passed screening in the ILR or CLRC, with the exception of animals in Youth Classes, Novice, Advanced, or Open Performance classes and Non-breeders class with vet certificate.

5. COPIES OF REGISTRATION PAPERS (INCLUDING JUVENILES) MUST BE SENT WITH THE ENTRY FORM show management for verification of name and age. Exhibitors must be registered owners and make entry in the exact names of both owner and animal as shown on the registration certificate or present a "Permission to Show" form signed by the registered owner. FAILURE TO MEET THESE REQUIREMENTS PROHIBITS ENTRY IN THE SHOW.
6. Completed entry forms, copies of registration papers, and proof of ALSA membership along with all fees should be postmarked no later than January 15, 2012.

7. No smoking in the barn or the arena.

Youth Classes: Llamas shown in Youth Classes may not be shown in Open Performance Classes. Detailed rules are found in the current ALSA Handbook. Per ALSA, all youth must be current 2012 ALSA youth members or must pay the non-ALSA youth fee of \$15.00. Youth ages 8 to 12 years of age will NOT be permitted to show an intact make over 24 months of age.

Sub-Junior (non ALSA): ages 5 through 7

Junior: ages 8 thru 11 years

Intermediate: ages 12 thru 14 years

Senior: ages 15- thru 18 years

All Youth ages are determined by January 1, 2012, except for 8 yr-olds, who are eligible to show as of their 8th birthday.

SASSRA INCENTIVES: The San Angelo Stock Show & Rodeo Association awards two incentives to youth exhibitors. These scholarships are based solely on the scoring in the performance classes on a weighted point system with high point names Junior Llama Show Champion and runner-up Junior Llama Show Reserve Champion.

The Champion winner will receive \$500 and the Reserve Champion winner will receive \$250. Incentives will be paid in full to the exhibitor and will be mailed with other premiums. Checks will go out approximately Mid-April. These champions will be named during the show on Sunday.

Pack Classes (Open and Youth): Animals must be 5 months of age or older. All exhibitors must provide their own saddle and panniers, or training pack as specified by the current ALSA Handbook.

Adult Showmanship: Adult Showmanship class is open to exhibitors aged 10 and older. (If a youth turns 19 during their final youth show season, they have the option to continue to show in the Senior Showmanship class, but if the youth shows in an Adult Showmanship class they no longer are eligible to complete in youth showmanship class.)

Wool Divisions:

Suri Wool: Suri llamas have a natural balanced, athletic type, which may appear narrower than llamas of other fiber types when viewed from the front or rear. The fleece of a Suri Llama should have a natural luster and hang and drape over the llamas body, usually forming a natural part of the spine. The fibers are grouped into very distinct and well-defined locks with many

individual separate locks of fiber formed at the skin and carrying out to the ends of each lock. The fleece should be lustrous, the locks independent and consistent in size, and the degree of wave or spiral content throughout the neck and body. The fiber is also characterized by absence of crimp and minimal loft.

Light Wool: Minimal body wool, short neck wool with smooth legs.

Medium Wool: Moderate to long body wool, minimal to moderate neck wool, smooth to moderate leg wool.

Heavy Wool: Abundant body and neck wool with minimal to abundant leg wool. (i.e., leg wool at least to knee and hock).

Produce of Dam and Get of Sire Classes: These classes are entered under the name of the Dam and Sire. Registration certificates of the Dam or Sire must be sent with the entry. If Dam &/or Sire is not present at the show, an ALSA fee of \$5.00 must be sent with the entry. There may be more than one entry for a Dam or Sire but only the top placing will earn points.

-Produce of Dam consists of two offspring by the same dam, each shown in appropriate halter classes.

-Get of Sire consists of three offspring by the same sire by a least two dams, each shown in appropriate class.

-Offspring must be designated to show management before these classes or held.

Age Divisions for Animals Entries: Age determined by the age of the llama on the day they enter the ring in halter.

Juvenile.....5 through 12 months

Two Year Olds.....25 through 36 months

Yearling.....13 through 24 months

Adult.....37 months and older

Show management reserves the right to combine wool divisions if lack of enough entries warrants the decision.

-Ribbons will be awarded in all classes for places 1-5. Banners will be awarded for all Grand and Reserve Champions

-Additional cash premiums are offered by the San Angelo Stock Show Association, the South Central Llama Association, Llama Breeders and Friends of the San Angelo Llama Show.
