- All rules apply to the Pygmy Goat Shows. Please refer to the General Rules and Junior Show Rules. This is a National Pygmy Goat Association sanctioned show. NPGA rules to govern and take precedence over all others.
- Each entry form must show the full name, address and social security number of the exhibitor, and all requested information in regards to the animal being entered. Information submitted on entry forms will be verified at registration when original registration certificates are presented to show officials. Health papers are required. Please review the Animal Health Regulation page.
- Entry forms and fees must be submitted by entry deadline. The entry fee is \$30.00 per head, which automatically enters the animal in both shows. There is no stall fee.
- All pygmy goats must be owned by the exhibitor by January 1 prior to the show date of the San Angelo Stock Show.
- Each animal shown in this division must be registered with the exception of wethers. An original certificate of registration will be checked at the show registration. Papers should be kept available at all times during the show for each animal exhibited and could be reviewed if any questions arise.
- Exhibitors are responsible for kid proofing their pens if necessary. Materials will not be provided by the show.
- No hay bales will be allowed inside the livestock barn. All hay brought in must be kept in a feed bag or bucket to prevent excessive hay in the pens and alleys. No hay racks or hay bags will be allowed inside the barn. Hay may be fed in feed troughs or tubs on the ground or hanging on the fence. Free range hay is not allowed and there should only be enough hay in a trough or tub for an animal to eat in a single feeding.
- Ages will be broken by age on the date of the show. If the exhibitor has an entry in a regular class, no additional entry fee is required; however, if no entry in another class, the entry fee is required in full.
- Premiums will be paid on a sliding scale and premium checks will be mailed to exhibitors after the show. Premiums are dependent on sponsorships.
