1. Any FFA Chapter or County 4-H Club in Texas may enter as many teams as they wish. Students that comprise each team are to be members of a 4-H Club or FFA Chapter. Entry must be made on an official entry form furnished by the San Angelo Stock Show.
2. Names of contestants must be submitted by their coaches to show officials before 9:30 a.m. the morning of the contest.
3. Competing teams will consist of 3 or 4 members with the lowest scoring member automatically becoming an alternate.
4. The contest format, including questions will originate from the “Wildlife and Recreation Management Study Guide: A Guide for Agricultural Science Teachers and 4-H Leaders State List.” The guide is available from *Instructional Materials Service, Department of Agriculture Education, College of Agriculture and Life Sciences, Texas A&M University, College Station, TX.* **Coaches should contact Instructional Materials Service prior to the contest for updates or changes to the contest guidelines.**
5. Scansheets will be provided by the San Angelo Stock Show & Rodeo Association.
6. Fifteen minutes will be allocated to complete each station in the contest with five minutes reserved to move between stations.
7. Ties will be broken by awarding the higher place to the individual or team scoring the highest in techniques portion. If still tied, the highest score in plant identification followed by the highest score on plant preference wins. In all cases, the committee’s decision is final.
8. A plaque will be awarded to the top five teams. The top scoring individual will receive a \$500.00 incentive and a plaque. The second through fifth place high individuals will receive plaques.
9. High point individuals in FFA and 4-H Senior divisions will receive a \$500.00 incentive made payable to the individual to be mailed by the end of April. Checks will be mailed to the 4-H or FFA Club through which they entered. Individuals are eligible for multiple incentives.
