Entry Fee: \$10.00 per fleece – Limit 4 Fleece per Class
Entry Deadline: 9:00 a.m., Friday, February 24, 2012 – Sale Pavilion
Time of Show: 11:00 a.m., Friday, February 24, 2012 – Sale Pavilion
Release: All fleeces must be picked up immediately following show

1. All rules apply to the Wool & Mohair Fleece Show. Please refer to the General Rules and Junior Show Rules (for the Junior Division).
2. The Show Committee reserves the right to interpret these rules and regulations and arbitrarily settle and determine all matters connected with the show. The Committee further reserves the right to amend or add to the rules set forth in this catalog.
3. All fleeces must be in place by 10:00 a.m. on Friday, February 24, 2012 at the Sale Pavilion. However, exhibitors may send their entries to the Stock Show Office as long as the fleeces arrive by Thursday, February 23, 2012. Exhibitors shall be solely responsible for their entries.
4. Loading and unloading is strictly prohibited on the front midway area. Please follow directional signs at location for unloading instructions.
5. Entries shall be judged on the following basis:

Length of Staple	Character
Uniformity of fiber diameter	Weight of Fleece
Yield	Preparation
Color or Luster	Strength
6. Judges shall not award a prize to an unworthy exhibit. The judges shall determine the method and points for scoring the fleeces.
7. **TWELVE MONTHS WOOL-** Fleeces from aged ewes shall not have over 13 months of growth. Fleece from yearling ewes shall not have over 16 months growth. Removal of bellies in fleeces is optional. Fleeces must be tied with paper twine.
8. **MOHAIR-** Fleeces shall not be over 8 inches in length. Micron Requirements:
Kid Class Fleeces- 30 Microns or Finer
Yearling Class Fleeces- 30-34 Microns
Adult Class Fleeces- 35 Microns or Coarser
All mohair fleeces must be spring shorn in the spring of 2011 or 2012. **FLEECES MUST BE ENTERED IN CLEAR PLASTIC BAGS.**
9. All wool and mohair fleeces must be produced by one animal and must be identified as fleeces of one animal. This rule will be strictly adhered to.
10. Exhibitors shall be disqualified for any of the following reasons: fleeces show an excessive amount of burrs, vegetable matter, discoloration by moisture, weakness of breaks, lack of due care in preparation and fleeces tied with anything other than paper twine.
11. It shall be the exhibitor's responsibility to enter the fleece in the proper class. Fleeces not meeting requirements for length and grade in the classes entered shall be disqualified from the show.

Each exhibitor may enter four (4) fleeces per class, however, the exhibitor will be eligible to receive only two money placings per class. Premium checks will be mailed following the show.
