Exhibitors flocked from all corners of the state in hopes their animal would be named Grand Champion of the Fall Spectacular held November 14 & 15, at the fairgrounds. This show featured some of the top stock of the 2009 summer show season, as the competition was intense. It also served as a practice run to get all the kinks worked out before the "Big Show" in February.

Families from Amarillo to La Porte, Marfa to Nevada, TX, made the haul to San Angelo to compete. Over 1,200 total entries flooded the office in just two days. Due to the abundance of entries, profits more than doubled from last year's show and are just expected to climb in the coming years.
