Jr. Barrel Race Competition

Parents and children, thank you for interest in the Jr. Barrel Race competition. This information sheet is for you to keep, however, the MINOR'S RELEASE and entry form must be returned to the committee for important contact information. **The Jr. Barrel Race competition is open for contestants 12 years of age and younger.**

Please legibly print all information for the committee and San Angelo Stock Show and Rodeo Association Staff to have your child's name pronounced correctly and for us to contact you with the status as to which rodeo performance your child will appear in.

Contestants must be able to have full control of their horses throughout their barrel runs to perform in a rodeo performance. If chosen to perform, children are required to ride the same horse they rode during try-outs. We ask that riders only need limited assistance in their performance. For example, help in the alley way or help stopping the horse after the run is fine, we do not want parents leading kids around the barrel pattern. This event is not a timed event and no awards are given- it is for enjoyment and entertainment only; therefore, speed is not important.

Rodeo performances will be selected within one week after tryouts. Parents will be contacted via telephone or e-mail by a committee member or San Angelo Stock Show and Rodeo staff member. Contestants chosen for rodeo performances will be given two **rodeo tickets (one for the child and one for a parent)** to the performance they are chosen for. Additional tickets must be purchased for additional family members wishing to attend. We cannot guarantee the seats will be in the same section as those given to the participant and parent, due to early ticket sales. Tickets for the contestant and parent will be left at the coliseum box office. Tickets are available for pickup between 10:00- 6:00 p.m. Monday thru Saturday. It is YOUR RESPONSIBILITY to go by the box office to pick up your child's envelope.

Contestants will perform following the WPRA Barrel Race in each nightly performance. It is crucial that your child be ready at this time. Contestants will be given the proper amount of time to get in the alley way and into the arena; however it is very important that this is done as quickly as possible. Parents may assist their children down the alley way.
