Challenge Rules and Regulations:

1. **Entry:** Each classroom may enter one (1) recycled piece of artwork. No limit per school or grade level applies. No individual person or small group may enter. Entries are open to Pre-K thru 5th grade and are not limited to the San Angelo area. No entry fee required. Entry forms can be found on www.sanangelorodeo.com, clicking on the RODEO tab, selecting Kid’s Activities on the left column, printing and either dropping them off at the Stock Show Office or mailing forms to:

2. **Drop-off:** All recycled artwork pieces must be hand-delivered to the San Angelo Stock Show and Rodeo(SASSRA) Qualtrust Exhibit Hall during drop-off hours.
3. **Admissible Artwork Requirements:** The focus of the Trash to Treasure Art Challenge is first and foremost an activity for more youth involvement in the SASSRA. Also, top priority is to encourage recycling to the younger generation students participating and inform all fairgrounds visitors about the positive effects of such an act. Therefore, at least 75% of the materials used in making the project should be recycled objects. Recycled or reuseable items include, but are not limited to: plastics, glass, metals, wood, Styrofoam, aluminum cans, newspapers, magazines, cardboard, etc... Basically any item that has been previously used, discarded, and can be utilized for reuse.

Artwork entries may include sculptures, ceramics, paintings, collages, mosaics, etc... There will be no particular size restraint or limitation. Any damages or alterations to projects while on display will not be the responsibility of the SASSRA.

The artwork will require an accompanied 1-page typed, double-spaced, 12 point, Times New Roman font description. The description should include a name for the project, list the names of the students involved in the making, describe the process of creating the artwork, and what the students learned from the challenge. Teacher help and involvement will be allowed.

Artwork deemed inappropriate includes photography, nude, violence, racial, and Satanic. Judges and the SASSRA will reserve the right to not accept such entries for competition.

4. **Creativity/ Originality:** Published art, printed materials, works, or reproduction of images will not be allowed for competition. This contest encourages creative capacities and will not tolerate replications or problems arising from copyright issues. Judges and the SASSRA will reserve the right to disqualify those entries. If this should happen after the judging takes place, the winners will forfeit any prizes. The SASSRA will not be responsible for any lawsuits or legal issues that arise from copyright infringements.

5. **Pick-up:** All entries will be required to be picked up at the designated time above by a particular person designated to be responsible for the artwork on the entry form. Artwork that is not picked up at this time will be properly recycled and discarded immediately.
